

## Dress Regulations - Juniors

### BOYS

Royal Blue Blazer
Long-sleeved, plain, white shirt <i>For Summer Term only, short-sleeved shirts may be worn</i>
A School House tie
Striped School pattern pullover or slipover
Dark charcoal grey trousers, plain and of sensible style  Short trousers may be worn when appropriate  <i>Denims or cords may not be worn</i>
Plain grey or black socks
Black polished, plain style shoes. Plain, black sandals may be worn in the Summer Term  <i>Trainers, suede shoes, boots, and shoes with coloured stitching are not permitted</i>
Navy blue coat, anorak style, <b>as provided by the School shop only</b> , or plain navy blue kagoule  <i>Children are expected to have a coat in School every day</i>

### GIRLS

Royal Blue Blazer
Long-sleeved, plain; white <i>For Summer Term only, optional summer issue white short sleeved shirt may be worn (Year 6 only)</i>
A School House tie
Striped School pattern pullover or slipover
School issue grey boxpleat knee-length skirt  Optional School issue summer dress – for Summer Term and early Autumn Term only <i>(until October half term)</i>
Plain white <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> socks or grey wool tights in Winter <i>Black tights are not permitted</i>  White ankle socks may be worn in Summer Term and in Autumn Term <i>(until October half term)</i>
Black, flat, plain style shoes. Plain, black sandals may be worn in the Summer Term  <i>Trainers, suede shoes, boots, and shoes with coloured stitching are not permitted</i>
Navy blue coat, anorak style, <b>as provided by the School shop only</b> , or plain navy blue kagoule  <i>Children are expected to have a coat in School every day</i>

### OPTIONAL

School Navy scarf with crest
Navy blue plain gloves
Winter hat as available from the School Shop
Summer cap (for sun protection) as available from the School Shop
Craft apron as available from the School Shop
Girls' hair accessories available from the School Shop

**It is expected that the children will have the following bags :**

School issue rucksack (in House colours) for carrying books, etc or black briefcase (no combination locks)
Sports bag (in House colours) for games kit/PE kit
Pump bag (in House colours) for swimming kit

**N.B. School Rules lay down that all articles of clothing, gym kit, musical instruments, personal belongings etc. must be clearly marked with the owner's name.**

## **APPEARANCE**

It is hoped that all children will endeavour to take a pride in their appearance, especially with regard to hair which must be kept neat and tidy, extreme or bizarre styles being unacceptable.

Boys' hair should be cut above shirt collar length.

Girls' long hair must be tied back, and accessories (slides, bands etc.) must be discreet (blue or tortoiseshell in colour).

Jewellery must not be worn except for wrist watches. Girls may wear plain stud earrings.

The Principal will be pleased to clarify any points or difficulty with regard to dress and appearance if so requested.

## **PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL ARTICLES ARE CLEARLY NAMED**

The school operates a lost property service and makes every effort to re-unite pupils with the majority of their lost belongings.

Please note that the School can not accept liability for loss of, or damage to, pupils' personal property including sports clothing and equipment whilst it is on or left at any of the School's premises. Such items should be clearly labelled with the pupil's name and, if necessary, high risk items should be covered on parent's household insurance policy separately. Such items should never be left overnight at School.

## **Dress for Physical Education, swimming and Games**

### **PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

For all timetabled PE lessons in the Gymnasium or Sports Hall the correct dress is as follows:-

#### **BOYS**

White polo shirt with School crest embroidered
Navy blue shorts
White ankle socks

#### **GIRLS**

White polo shirt with School crest embroidered
Royal blue shorts
White ankle socks

**Please note:**

- Training shoes are not allowed in the gymnasium
- **Clean** training shoes are allowed in the Sports Hall

## SWIMMING

### BOYS

For swimming lessons all boys must be equipped with swimming trunks and a towel
School issue swimming trunks are available from the School Shop
A swimming cap will be necessary in House colours

### GIRLS

For swimming lessons all girls must be equipped with a swimming costume and a towel
School issue swimming costume is available from the School Shop
A swimming cap will be necessary in House colours

## GAMES

For all outdoor games the correct dress is as follows:-

### BOYS

#### Autumn/Spring Terms

School issue tracksuit
Blue/blue & white reversible long-sleeved jersey
Plain navy blue shorts with school crest
Royal blue football socks
Shin pads
Football boots
Training shoes (for all-weather surfaces)
School sweatshirt
Mouthguard is compulsory (for Rugby/Hockey)
A towel for showering

### GIRLS

#### Autumn/Spring Terms

School issue tracksuit
White polo shirt with School crest embroidered
Royal blue skirt and shorts
Royal blue knee-length socks for hockey
White ankle socks for netball
Training shoes
School sweatshirt
Shin guards
Mouthguard is compulsory (for Hockey)
A towel for showering

### BOYS

#### Summer Term

##### Cricket

Boys may wear winter games kit, or :

White long-sleeved shirt
Tracksuit bottoms/cricket whites
White cricket sweater/School sweatshirt
White ankle socks
Training shoes (cricket boots are only necessary for team members)

### GIRLS

#### Summer Term

Same as for Autumn/Spring Terms
Girls may wear School PE shorts and white ankle socks for athletics

##### Other outdoor Summer sports

PE kit or Winter games kit as preferred, with training shoes
--

**Please note:**

- Boys are not permitted to wear the same shirt or socks for cricket and everyday wear.
- Girls are not permitted to wear the same socks for games and everyday wear.
- Under no circumstances should children go home wearing the same clothes that they have been wearing for games.
- All games and PE kit should be clearly marked with the owner's name.

**The following regulations apply to dress to and from competitive School fixtures:**

**BOYS**

**Football**

Full School uniform

School team strip will usually be provided for A and B matches otherwise normal games kit is to be worn

**Cricket**

'A' teams: Full cricket whites, including white trainers/boots, with blazer on top

For B team players, royal blue tracksuit bottoms may be worn

**Athletics/Cross Country**

PE kit with school tracksuit over  
School crested vest may be provided

**GIRLS**

**Netball/Rounders**

Full School uniform

Bibs, team shirts, etc will normally be provided, otherwise normal games kit is to be worn

**Athletics/Cross Country**

PE kit with School tracksuit over  
School crested vests may be provided
